Ancestors of Mrs. Sophia (Bradley) Batchelder Ingalls.

Sophia (Bradley) B. Ingalls was daughter of Philbrick and Sarah (Emery) Bradley of Concord. He was in the Revolutionary War and was slightly wounded. He was son of Timothy and Abiah (Stevens) Bradley.

Timothy was son of Abraham and Elizabeth Philbrick Bradley of Haverhill, Mass. Abraham settled in Concord as early as 1729. His wife Elizabeth Philbrick was daughter of Thomas and Mchitable (Ayres) Philbrick.

Thomas³ was son of James and Ann (Roberts) Philbrick.

James² was son of Thomas and — Philbrick who came from Lincolnshire, England about 1630, and settled first in Watertown Mass., removed to Hampton in 1650-1651 and died in 1667. His wife Elizabeth died Dec. 19, 1663.

Sophia (Bradley) Ingalls' mother, Sarah (Emery) Bradley was daughter of Capt. Charles

and Sarah (Bailey²) Emery of Concord.
Capt. Bailey was of Revolutionary fame.
He was a direct descendant of Anthony
and Agnes Emery. Anthony was born
in Romsey England and came to
America in ship "James" landing in
Boston June 3, 1635. He lived in Newbury
until 1640, removed to Dover N. H. He
was living in Portsmouth in 1680.

Sophia Bradley married first — Batchelder
of Loudon and had two children. Sarah
married Alancelot Rood and lived in
the West. Joseph Warren was a Congregational
minister and missionary in India from
1838 to 1854. He then returned home and
settled in the West. He was Chaplain
in the Civil War, and was taken prisoner
but escaped and returned home. After
peace was declared he returned to India
and died there just before the famine.
He had three children. Charles Warren and
Margaret settled in Washington, D. C. Edwin

was in the Civil War, and taken
prisoner and starved in Rebel prison.
Sophia (Bradley) Batchelder married
second Nathaniel Babady Ingalls of
Canterbury.
