N.H. Oct-10, 1773, died Feb. 15-
1818, grandmother Betsy Burns
Burns Dow, born Aug. 17, 1775
died Feb. 11, 1841.

Jonathan S. Dow, was the
seventh child of a family
of eight. he was born at
Pittsfield N.H. June 3, 1812
died at Canterbury Feb. 11, 1880

Frank's grandfather French was
Enoch French, grandmother was
Hannah Wallace, French.

Frank's mother was Henrietta
S French, born at Loudon N.H.
Dec. 19, 1807, died Aug. 23, 1885

Jonathan S. Dow married
Henrietta S. French Jan 3 1835
They always lived at Canterbury
after they were married the
children born to them were
Betty B. born Aug 9. 1836
married to Lane of Candia
she died there ^{in Feb. 1896} she left one
son J. J. Lane, who at present
is living in Everett Mass. he
is married and has two sons

Enoch F. born Mar 30. 1839
died Sept. 1 1842
Abbie A. born Aug 5. 1841
married George Lane of
Danvers Mass. she died there ^{in May}
Harriett A. born Mar 30. 1844
is married to N A Pitts

lives there,

Amanda M. born Mar 3, 1847
married Byron Hobert - of Lebanon
she died at Canterbury N H ^{Aug. 1871}

Frank P. born June 30, 1850
still living at Canterbury N H

Frank ~~13~~¹² Dow married
Adeline West of Chester-
Sept. 25, 1873. ^{in Chester}

I was born Dec 19, 1855;
our children were both
born at Canterbury N H

Hellie ~~Adeline~~ born July 25, 1876
died at Canterbury N H
Oct. 5, 1906,

George ~~West~~ born Oct-6, 1880
died at Fitchburg Mass
April 4, 1911.

I have written this in a
hurry but you can perhaps
get a little idea of our
history and arrange it to
suit your self. If I could
see you I could explain
it better than I can write
it. Father Dew had only
two brothers that grew to man-
hood. Jeremiah was a school
teacher for many years in
Wilkesbarre Penn. died there
quite old. a few years a-
go. he left five children
one brother Philip went to
Australia many years ago
(but since Frank can remember)
and was never heard from
after the most of his
sisters died young but -

one was married and went-
to Iowa, and died there she
left a number of children.
their and one sister lived
and died in Epsom. she
was married to a Mr
Chapman and had a
number of children. some
live there now.

Another Dore family were
all girls that lived to
be grown, and they married
and lived and died in
Mass. all but the youngest -
she married and lived
and died in Canada.

there are some cousins in
Mass. but we have lost-
acquaintance with them.

I don't expect this on this
sheet is of any interest
in the history I just got -
to writing so wrote it to you.
