George Washington Fletcher, son of Josiah S. and Louisa P. Fletcher was born in Loudon, N. H. April 7, 1852. He attended the common schools until he was prepared to go to a higher school and then attended Tilton Seminary several terms. At twenty years of age he became a clerk in Concord, N. H. where he remained some two years. Then returning home he soon after engaged in farming interest in Canterbury. In 1882 he bought the John Keyer farm in Canterbury known as the Hancock House, This being the homestead of John Keyer, donor of Keyer Seminary, where he settled and was engaged in general farming and in providing in summer time a pleasant resort for twenty five or more persons seeking rest and recreation. Mr. Fletcher is a well informed citizen and alive to all matters affecting the welfare of the

Schools, churches, agricultural affairs and general welfare of the people of the community in which he resides. He was a member of the First Free Baptist Church, serving as deacon, clerk, and chairman of Executive Committee for a number of years until leaving town. He is a member of the board of trustees of Keizer Seminary Canterbury. In political faith he is a Republican and has been selectman four years, during one year of which time he was chairman of the board, overseer of the poor and is justice of the peace for the state. He married in Newport, N. H. Dec. 21, 1882 Mattie C. Colby who was born in Grantham Aug. 27, 1858 daughter of Hiram and Florenda Colby. They have one child Harold G. born Aug 10, 1899. In March 1907 Mr. Fletcher sold his farm and moved to Concord. He now holds a position with the Page Belting Company as foreman of the assorting department, with residence at 22 Washington St.

Mr. Fletcher traces his ancestry back five generations to Gideon Fletcher of Dunstable, Mass. He had five sons; Joshua, John, Daniel, Josiah, and Samuel. His son Daniel² was great-grandfather of Mr. Fletcher. He removed with his family from Dunstable to Leantow, where all his children, but the three oldest, joined the Shakers. Daniel's son John³ was born 25 January 1770; married Betsey Morrill daughter of — Morrill of Gilmanston. John Fletcher died 13-December 1853; his wife died 18 June 1857. Josiah S.⁴ Fletcher son of John was born 6 April 1814; married Louisa daughter of Mark and Sally (Brown) Prescott. He died 15-November 1889, his wife died 25-August 1910

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Battie (Colby) Fletcher, daughter of Hiram and Florenda (Blough) Colby, was born in Grantham N. H., Aug. 27, 1858. After an education obtained in the town schools, New Hampton L. I. and Kimball Union Academy, Meriden, and several years experience as school teacher in various towns in New Hampshire and Vermont she married George W. Fletcher Dec. 21, 1882 and lived in Canterbury for twenty four years. In the church, Sunday-school, grange and society she took an active part. She was superintendent of the Sunday-school for eighteen years, secretary of the grange two years, member of the School-board three years and president of the Baptist and Yezer Union for eight years. In the home she was true to its interests and always thoughtful to add to the comforts of her many summer guests.
