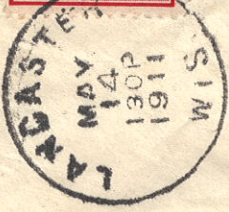

2. Minerva. married A. W. Smith about 1832.
Died in Cleveland, O. about 1881. Had lost
2 infants. Left none.

3. Jane. Married Fremer Rosworth about 1833.
Died in Solon, O. about 1889. Had 2 sons.
Orville, died about the time she did, leaving
widow and child. Newton, is a hardware
merchant in Cleveland, O. with wife & 4
children.

4. Catherine. Married Henry B. Chase, 1837. Died
in Rockford, Ill. 1903. Had 6 sons, 1
daughter. 2 sons dead each leaving 2 chil-
dren. 2 sons in Chicago, with families, 1
in Rockford, 1 in Colorado Springs, Col. the
daughter married & living in Rockford, Ill.
All have children.

5. Charles. Married Helen Lill, 1838. Died 1909
in Traverse City, Mich. had 10 children. 4
are living 1 daughter & 1 son in Traverse City. 1
son, in Cleveland, O. 1 son in Alpena, Mich.
1 son. has 3 children, the other 1
1 son has 2 .. I think & the other 1.

6. William, Foster, Married Julia M. Barnard,
1838. Died May 1-1901, in Grand
Blaine, Mich. 2 sons died in infancy.
left 3 sons. Ellen, wife of Rev. George
Bishop, Grand Blaine. son (who is myself)
& a son. Hope, wife of W. H. Bremer of
Belle Fourche, S. Dakota.
Ellen has 4 sons. I have 2 sons & 1 son.

7. Lyman B. Married Mary Whinfield about 1868.
Died about 1890 in Calumet, P.Q. Canada.
left 4 daughters, 2 married & with families, in
Canada. 1 married, in Mexico. 1 son, also in Mexico
1 son. unmarried, in Watertown. N. Y.

8. John. R. Married Ella Beardsley about 1873.
Died 1909 in Cleveland, O. leaving 2 sons both
unmarried.

again & had one daughter by the 2nd wife
who is now a widow, with no child, living
in Cleveland, where her mother died on Oct.
9th, while I was in Canterbury. I visited
the Cleveland relatives on my way home.
